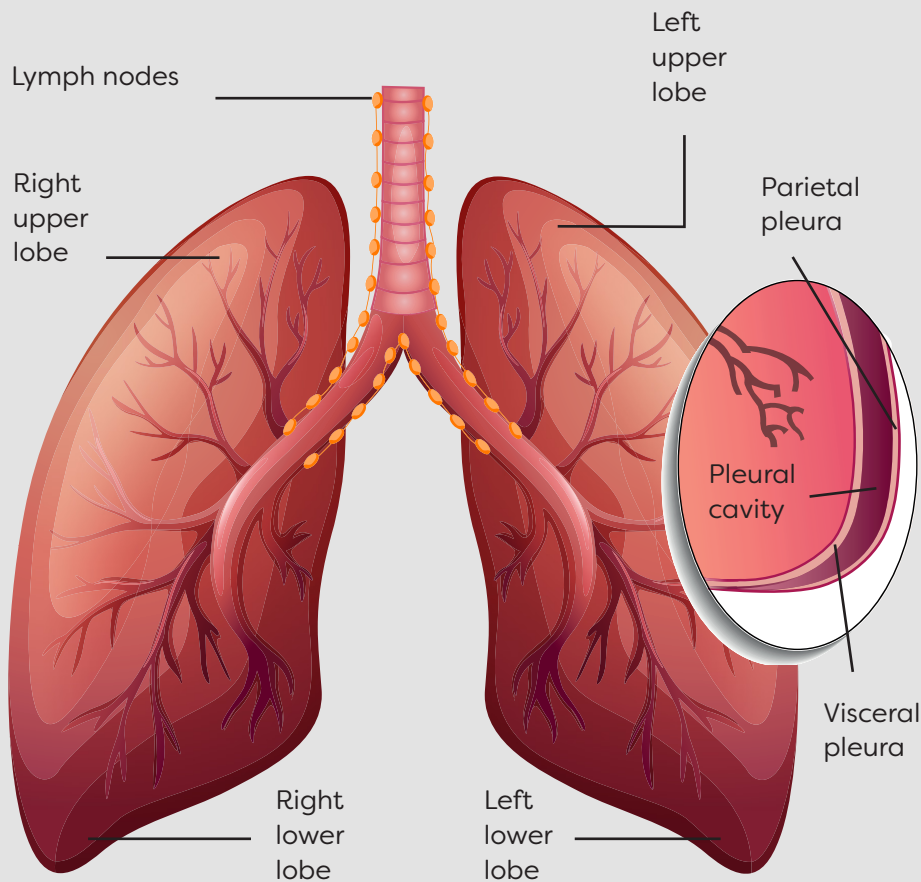

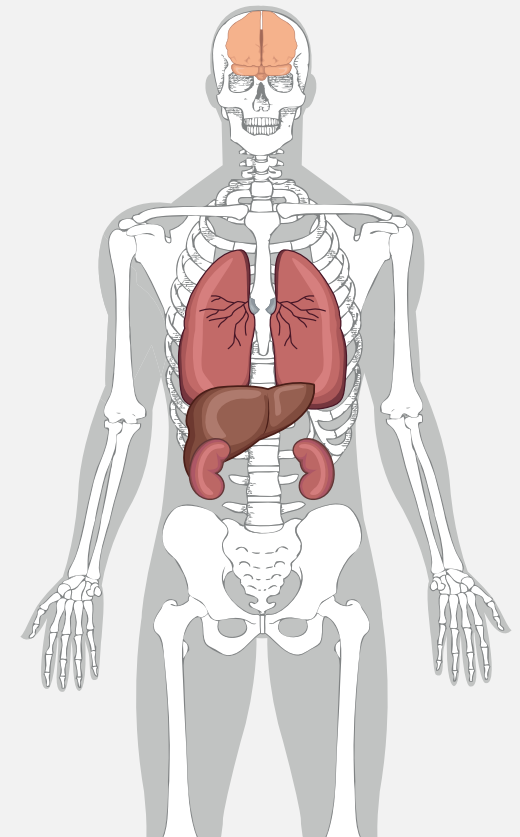


Stage of disease progression

The stage represents the extent of spread of a given cancer. It is based on the TNM classification (tumour size, lymph nodes, metastases).

- Stage I**
(localized to the lung)
- Stage II**
(nearby lymph nodes)
- Stage III**
(regional spread, lymph nodes and/or adjacent tissues)
- Stage IV**
(distant metastases)

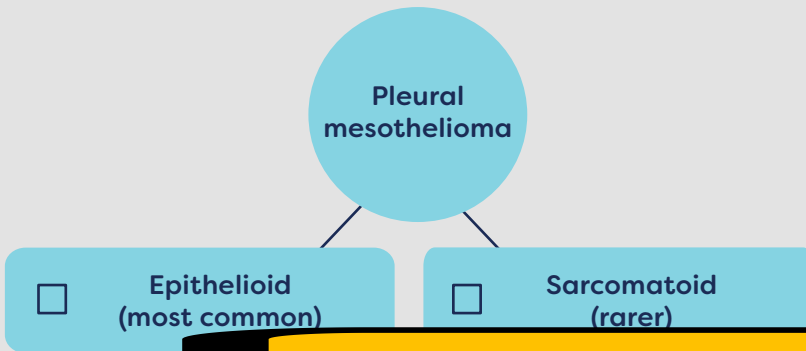
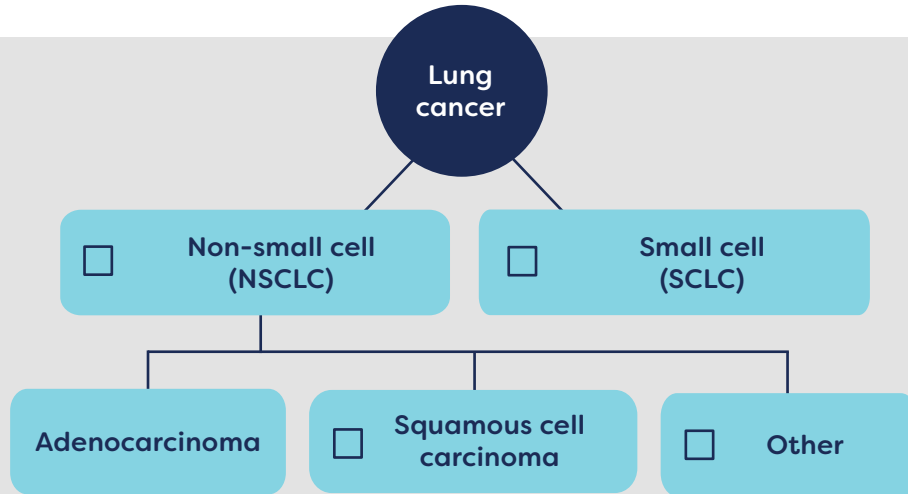
If metastases are present, use this diagram to indicate the location (brain, bones, liver, etc.).
